
THE SILENT AUCTION COUNTDOWN! You Are Needed!

OACRAO FEE NOTIFICATION

The Board of Directors is recommending a membership dues increase that will be incorporated into the proposed budget, which will be voted upon at the business lunch at the OACRAO annual meeting to be held at the conference in October. The dues increase will be presented and discussed at the town hall breakfast. The Board motioned to pass an increase that will raise institutional membership dues by \$50 across all brackets. See below for the current bracket fees compared to the proposed model.

While OACRAO is continuously being cognizant of how to be good financial stewards of the organization's resources, operational costs continue to increase. This increase will enable us to continue to offer workshops and the conference experience that our membership expects from us, while remaining financially sound and not increasing other costs dramatically. Membership dues were last increased in 2007.

The OACRAO by-law policy requires notification prior to the Annual meeting where the voting membership will pass the annual budget. The increase will take effect with the membership year beginning September 1, 2019, if approved.

- Clarify the duties of the Vice President/Workshops by enhancing the bylaws description of the role
- Improve consistency in the use of commas
- Improve consistency in referring to "the Association" throughout the document
- Improve consistency in the use of capitalization for specific titles
- Appropriate use of hyphens where applicable
- Correction of minor formatting issues throughout



A draft of these suggested changes has been shared via the listserv. The bylaws changes will be discussed at the Town Hall Breakfast, and voted upon at the Business Lunch, as part of the upcoming 2018 Annual Meeting. See you there!
